Begin by reciting the Anima Christi on the crucifix

 Water from the side of Christ, wash me.
 Passion of Christ, strengthen me,
 O good Jesus, hear me,
 Within Thy wounds hide me,
 Separated from Thee let me never be,
 From the malicious enemy defend me,
 In the hour of my death call me
 and bid me come unto Thee
 That I may praise Thee
 with Thy saints Forever and ever. Amen.

On each "large" bead, recite:

Leader 1 "Jesus, meek and humble of Heart,

Leader 2: make my heart like unto Thine."

On each “small” bead group, recite:

Leader 1: “Sweet Heart of Jesus,

Leader 2: Be Thou my love!”

After each “small” bead group of six, recite:

Leader 1: “Sweet Heart of Mary,

Leader 2: be my salvation!”

At the conclusion of the Chaplet, recite:

Leader 1: “O Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, have mercy on us. O Immaculate Heart of Mary, pray for us. May the Sacred Heart of Jesus be praised, glorified, loved and preserved throughout the world now and forever more. Amen.”
